IMPORTANT: PLEASE CHECK YOUR EQUIPMENT

1 X FLYSHEET (OR OUTER)

1 X SINGLE POINT INFLATION OXYGEN AIR FRAME TUBE

1 X TWO BERTH INNER TENT

1 X BAG OF STEEL GROUND PEGS

1 X CARRY BAG

GUYLINES



We highly recommend that you insure your annexe against storm damage, or accidental damage, as the warranty does not cover such eventualities. The manufacturer IS NOT liable for any damage caused to the annexe, or its contents, as a result of misuse, incorrect pitching, or severe weather conditions; full warranty details can be found on the rear of this booklet.

NOTES

- Damage caused by incorrect maintenance of the product.
- Flaws in the fabric caused by excessive use.
- Imperfections and pulls in mesh doors due to wear and tear.
- Water ingress through fabric as a result of accelerated UV degradation due to long term pitch .
- Water ingress through seams caused by excessive abrasion of seams or taped seam.
- Broken zips caused by over tensioning, forcing or snagging.
- Over tensioned/stretched seams coming apart.
- Buckles subjected to undue force or abrasion.
- Lost/popped out eyelets.
- Broken holdalls.
- Pole breakages or tube punctures (where applicable).
- Collateral damage from a pole breakage.
- Condensation, (a natural occurrence, exacerbated by insufficient ventilation opening).
- Consequential damage/loss to property/belongings (either inside or outside of the product) or shortening of holidays.

Outdoor Revolution work very closely with our retail partners to manage all warranty repairs/issues:

Please contact your retailer immediately (even if purchased online) if you feel your Outdoor Revolution product has a genuine warranty issue. The retailer, in turn will raise the issue with ourselves and we will action; with the retailer, according to the nature of the claim.

Returning Products

Please ensure the product is clean and dry and as close to its original condition as possible before sending back for checking. Wet or dirty products will not be accepted back for checking/warranty claims.

It is important to note that the Sales Contract between yourself and the retailer you purchased the Outdoor Revolution product from, remains valid throughout any warranty claim and your statutory rights are not affected.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- ◆ Please do not leave for your holiday without fully erecting and checking that you have all the listed contents for your annexe. If you are missing anything, then please contact your retailer immediately before use.
- ◆ Please note that man-made fabrics are prone to condensation, when the warm air and moisture within the annexe, comes into contact with the colder air on the outer material; this is a perfectly natural occurrence and should not be confused with leaking. Please ensure that all ventilation points remain open, wherever possible, in order to help combat condensation.
- ◆ We suggest that you pitch your annexe for some period of time before use, enabling it to undergo the 'weathering' process. Weathering sometimes requires a few uses of annexe, before becoming effective. Seam sealant can be used to resolve any persistent weeps; this is a natural process. 'Weathering' is the process of allowing your annexe to become soaked, then dried, approximately two to three times, in order to reinforce the waterproofing of the seams/stitching on the flysheet.
- ◆ Please ensure that you site the annexe on clear/level ground before erecting, with no sharp objects beneath it and zips fully closed. We suggest placing a groundsheet underneath the annexe to keep it dry/clean.
- ◆ We suggest conducting a trial run of your annexe to familiarise yourself with the assembly/usability of it. Should you have any issues pertaining to the erection process, then please contact a dealer for assistance before your holiday.
- ◆ This annexe is designed for short term usage and not long term pitch.
- ◆ Always dry/air the annexe after use, before packing away, to prevent mildew or mould from developing.
- ◆ Any dirt or stains can be removed by brushing, or gently washing, using warm water. DO NOT use detergents, as this will destroy the water resistance of the materials.
- ◆ DO NOT cook or smoke inside this annexe, as despite the outer fabric being flame-retardant; it can still melt.
- ◆ In the event of damage; please contact your retailer. If, for whatever reason, you are unable to contact them, then please email cs@blue-diamond-products.co.uk and our dedicated customer service team will be pleased to assist you.
- ◆ Please avoid using this annexe in temperatures below freezing, as this can result in detrimental impact on the Oxygen Air Frame.
- ◆ Always store your annexe bag flat, rather than on its side, as well as in a cool/dry area, in order to avoid any detrimental impact on the Oxygen Air Frame.

You must register for the **LIFETIME GUARANTEE** on the Outdoor Revolution website within **fourteen days** of the purchase to **validate** the warranty.

OUTDOOR REVOLUTION GUARANTEE

Outdoor Revolution products are designed and produced to the highest manufacturing standards. The best quality fabrics and components available are used for each specific item and rigorous checking of finished products is in place.

All finished products are:-

- Checked for and are free of minor defects
- Are fit for the purpose/use that they are intended
- Are of a satisfactory quality

It is important that correct care is taken when opening the product, erecting, using and just as importantly, packing away the product. Following these rules will keep your product in reliable working condition for many years. Failure to adhere to these simple guideline may cause unnecessary damage to the product (see formal instructions for hints and tips on handling/erecting the product). A repair kit is included in the product to help resolve any minor issues.

THE WARRANTY

The Outdoor Revolution Warranty lasts for 12 months from the original date of purchase (please keep all receipts or copies of any relevant transaction to substantiate the purchase date). The warranty only covers workmanship and fabric/components. Any faults found within 6 months of purchase will be investigated by Outdoor Revolution. Faults found outside of the initial six months of purchase will need to be proven by you the purchaser, in line with current consumer legislation after the short term right to reject has ended.

Retailer will not refund a purchase if no fault is found.

The manufactures warranty does not cover the following:-

- General wear and tear over extended periods of use or, seasonal pitching of the product.
- Accelerated UV damage caused by excessive, long term sun exposure.
- Accidental damage caused by but not exclusive to, human, animal or weather.

PACKING AWAY YOUR ANNEXE

- ◆ Extract the ground pegs from any secured guylines, storm straps and/or most of the pegs surrounding the annexe, leaving the four corners pegged down.
- ◆ Push the Dynamic Speed Valve button in; please ensure that the Oxygen Air Frame Tube has been completely deflated before packing away.
- ◆ Unpeg each of the four corners.
- ◆ Lay the annexe canvas flat on the ground.



1. Fold the annexe vertically, from the opposite ends to the valves, ensuring that all of the air is pushed out, creating a streamlined sausage shape.

2. Measure the width of the carry bag up against the width of the folded annexe to ensure that the annexe will fit inside.



3. Begin to roll the annexe as tight as possible towards the valves to expel all the air as you roll.

4. Place the rolled annexe onto the bag, pull the sides up around it, then zip up the bag.

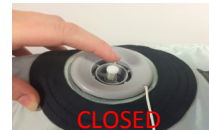
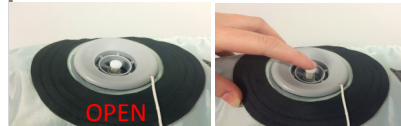
TIP: Refer to the photographs for assistance when erecting your **Eclipse Pro Conservatory Annexe**.

1. Spread the annexe canvas out flat on the ground next to your caravan awning, with the zip nearest the door you wish to attach it to.



2. Zip out the side door panel on the compatible **Eclipse Pro 380** caravan awning, on the side that you intend to attach the annexe to. Store the door panel somewhere dry/clean.

3. Zip the annexe onto the corresponding zip on the side access point, ensuring that the material is not pulled viciously and that no parts of the fabric become caught in the zip.



4. Locate the **Dynamic Speed Valve** and ensure that the valve is **closed**, before inserting the pump nozzle; the valve is closed when the button is pressed out. There is a valve at the other end of the tube; please ensure this is also closed.

5. Insert the pump nozzle into the **Dynamic Speed Valve** and begin to carefully inflate, ensuring that no part of the fabric have caught anywhere.





6. Inflate the **Oxygen Air Frame** until you can give it a 'good squeeze'; the tube requires room inside for air to expand, should there be any fluctuations in the ambient temperature. Don't be concerned if you do keep inflating, however, as the **Intelligent Frame Relief Valve** will release any excess air above 6PSI.

7. Replace the cap and cover it using the sleeve, in order to help maintain a neater external aesthetic.



8. Tension the front of the annexe, securing each pegging point, in order to tension the annexe as much as you desire. Please be careful to not overtension the fabric; if it becomes too tight, then release some tension.

8. Insert the pump nozzle into the **Dynamic Speed Valve** and begin to carefully inflate, ensuring that no part of the fabric have caught anywhere.

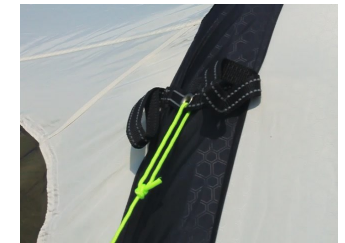


9. Lay the two berth inner tent inside the annexe, then starting at the back, begin clipping each plastic 'c' clip onto the designated attachment points on the floor, before matching the coloured elastic to the coloured loop.



10. Begin working your way around the inner tent, clipping the toggles into the corresponding elastic loops in the annexe, until the entire unit is in place. This can be removed to create extra living/storage space, should you so desire.

11. Secure any remaining pegging points, guylines and storm straps around the annexe to ensure that it is securely held in position.



12. Place any sleeping equipment inside the annexe inner tent and enjoy your holiday from a relaxing multi-functional conservatory space!

WARNING: Never unzip the zips on the protective sleeves whilst the Oxygen Air Frame Tubes are inflated; this will result in the tube bursting/ballooning out of the sleeve, causing damage to the tube *and* sleeve; this is NOT covered under the warranty!
